Applicants must use the form provided. Use extra sheets if necessary.

List school activities, school service organizations, and leadership positions and offices held while in high school. If a school service organization or activity, describe and give approximate number of hours devoted to service.

List community activities and service organizations, and leadership positions and offices held. If a community service organization or activity, describe and give approximate number of hours devoted to these activities/service.

Knowledge of Rotary and Service Above Self (20%)

To gain the highest score, the applicant must demonstrate a basic knowledge of Rotary and discuss concisely and comprehensively the concept of Service Above Self, how the applicant has applied it to everyday life, and how the applicant sees the concept playing a part in her/his future. The paper must be narrative in form, typewritten, and contain between 500-650 words.

Financial Need (20%)

The Expected Family Contribution (EFC) calculated from the Free Application for Federal Student Aid is the determining factor for establishing financial need. **Note: taxes need not be filed in order to complete the application.** The system allows the applicant to file an estimate. Forms can be obtained from school counselors, public libraries, and one on-line at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Complete the application as soon as possible after January 1, 2007. Attach a copy of the Student Aid Report (SAR) or a document which shows the estimated Expected Family Contribution (EFC) calculated through the application process.

Merit/Extenuating Circumstances (5%)

Submit a typewritten explanation not longer than one page telling why you deserve the scholarship and if there are any compelling and/or compassionate reasons why you deserve top consideration.
